### **GENERAL ALL CAMP INFORMATION:**

**A.M. or P.M. Care-** The early care begins as early as 7:00 a.m. Drop off at the gymnasium. After care ends promptly at 5:30 p.m.



**LITTLE BUDS-** The following section is information specifically pertaining to LITTLE BUDS ages 2-5. If you do not have a Little Bud, please skip to the next section.

### **WHAT TO BRING TO CAMP label everything you send to camp.**

**\*Full day campers** - Bathing suit, towel & sunscreen required **daily** for water play. Please apply sunscreen in a.m., we will re-apply in the afternoon, if necessary

**\*Half day campers** – Water play for mini campers alternates between mornings and afternoons when possible. Please check your child's weekly schedule to determine if you should send them to camp in their swimsuits for morning water play.(please apply sunscreen in the a.m.)

**NO food, NO toys please!** We ask that you do not allow your child to bring any items such as food, toys, money, books, etc. to camp (unless we previously discussed special accommodations).

**Morning Drop Off-** \*Please refer to the car flow diagram attached. Our regular morning drop off begins at **8:45 a.m.** It is not unusual for there to be some separation tears. We are well equipped to handle.

**EXTENDED CARE** Extended Care is available Monday – Friday from 7:00 – 9:00 a.m. and 3:30 – 5:30 p.m. Please drop off at the Parish Center Gymnasium and walk your child in. The attending staff will sign them in and take their temperature reading (while in yellow phase).

PM Extended care at Little Buds ends at 5:30 p.m. Please pick up in the cafeteria.



**BIG OAK DAY CAMP- The following section is information specifically pertaining to Big Oak, ages 6-14**

**Groupings:** Co-ed groups will be done based on the grade camper will be entering the following school year. Camper must have completed kindergarten and entering first grade to be eligible for Big Oak.

**Morning Drop Off-** \*Please refer to the car flow diagram that is attached. Please do not drop off before 8:45 a.m. or until our staff is in place. **AM & PM Extended care information is addressed in another section below.**

**Dismissal snacks-** Big Oak have the option to purchased a variety of ice cream treats and non-carbonated, sugar free drinks at the end of the day. Most snacks range from \$1-\$3. We do not sell soda.

**Swim-** Big Oak campers typically travel off-campus 2-3 times a week for supervised swim. All campers are swim tested before being allowed to enter pool. Beginners will be required to wear a Coast Guard approved life vest which is provided by the pool. There are lifeguards as well as our staff that supervise the campers. Bathing suit and towel should come to camp every day. Make sure everything is labeled.

**Cell Phones-** We will ask campers to **NOT** have their phones out during the camp day. You may get messages to your children through any of the contact numbers provided at the start of this letter.

**Boys & Girls. footwear** – **Flip flops are an absolute NO, NO and not appropriate for our level of activity and types of games**

**EXPRESSIONS DAY CAMP- The following section is information specifically pertaining to Expressions**

**Morning Drop Off-** \*Please refer to the car flow diagram. Our regular morning drop off begins at 8:45. Or when staff are out front. Please do not drop off early.

**Dismissal snacks-** Expressions campers may purchase end of day treats at the camp store. We offer a variety of ice cream treats and non-carbonated, sugar free drinks, snacks bags, etc. Most snacks range from \$1-\$3. We do not sell soda.

**Swim-** Expression campers typically travel off-campus 2 times a week for supervised swim. All campers are swim tested before being allowed to enter pool. Beginners will be required to wear a Coast Guard approved life vest which is provided by the pool. There are lifeguards as well as our staff that supervise the campers. Bathing suit and towel should come to camp every day. Make sure everything is labeled.

**Cell Phones & electronics-** We will ask campers to NOT have their phones out during the camp day. You may get messages to your children through any of the contact numbers provided at the start of this letter. If your child has electronics for communication purposes, please discuss this with Debbie prior to the start of camp.
